Dear Honorable Commissioner
William A. Anderson,

Attached is an envelope containing my Trial by Declaration that I attempted to deliver to the Corona Court last Friday afternoon and this morning.

I am writing this letter at about 9AM on Tuesday of the date of this letter. I have just returned from driving from Rancho Cucamonga to the Corona Court in my second futile attempt to deliver the subject document to the Corona Court.

As you are aware, yesterday, Monday, 1/21/2013, was the holiday for Martin Luther King and I was told last Friday afternoon that your facility would be closed. I arrived at the Corona Court last Friday afternoon about 4:15PM just in time to see and talk briefly with about 4 people who were leaving the building. I explained that I wanted to submit the subject document to Room 201 and they, in passing, said that it was too late that day and they were leaving. I asked two women if I could just throw my envelope on the floor near the security guard station and they said that they could not allow that. I had previously asked another woman if she would take it up to Room 201-she said "no", that it was after hours and there was no one there at this time. I asked all three women if there was a dropbox or mail slot into which I could deposit the subject document and they indicated negatively. I asked a man leaving the facility the same types of questions and he said that there was a mail slot on the opposite side of the building (visible by looking through the doors from which he was leaving). After he left and I went to the other side of the building, I found that the mail slot had been welded shut and there was a sign indicating that this mail slot was no longer an acceptable means for leaving mail. NOT ONE OF THESE PEOPLE INDICATED THAT I WAS TRYING TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE BY PERSONALLY DELIVERING THE DOCUMENT TO THE CORONA COURT. I checked the court papers that I received and there was no
